ShredStation, a Bensalem, Pa.-based company that provides document vaults to banks and office complexes, contracting with local firms that provide secure shredding services to destroy the documents, has offered Marcia Cross of "Desperate Housewives" a lifetime of free shredding.

ShredStation's offer comes after the hauling company that was removing Cross's trash discovered her tax returns as well as photos of Cross when dumping the material at a landfill.


The company is also offering publicists' offices in Los Angeles a free ShredStation vault and one year of free shredding service. Publicists interested in receiving a complimentary ShredStation vault should call (877) 89-VAULT.

ShredStation vaults measure roughly 4 feet in height and resemble FedEx or DHL package drop boxes. The contents of the vaults are destroyed by local document destruction firms.
